

Beat the Bugs - Head Lice Information

Prior to half term we sent home with your child information on how to look for and treat head lice along with a free comb. To help combat head lice it is important you check your child on a **weekly basis**. Why not choose a particular bath night each week and make it part of your normal routine.



Reduce the chance of your child getting head lice by:

- Familiarise yourself with what head lice and eggs look like. It's a good idea to know what you're looking for.
- Use the comb and ensure you are using it correctly.
 Information is available on our website. If your child has very thick/curly hair use a detangling spray or conditioner.
- Check your child once a week. Look closely at the back hairline and behind the ears, where lice tend to populate. It can take up to 6 weeks to experience itching.
- Advise children not to share hats, hairbands, brushes, headphones, hoodies and scarfs etc. Lice can live for 1-2 days without a host.
- Advise children not to play with each others hair.
- Use shampoo and conditioner for lice prevention. Lice don't like particular smells such as lavender, eucalyptus, tea tree and lemon grass. Choose a shampoo with these smells for added protection.
- Keeping hair tied up in a plat or a bun will lower the chances of an infestation. Pony tails still tend to 'flick' which allows lice to transfer from head to head.
- Look out for frequent head scratching.
- If you find lice treat. Advice and FREE lotion is available from your local pharmacy.
