

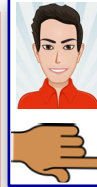

**Please Do Not Park in the GP Car Park**

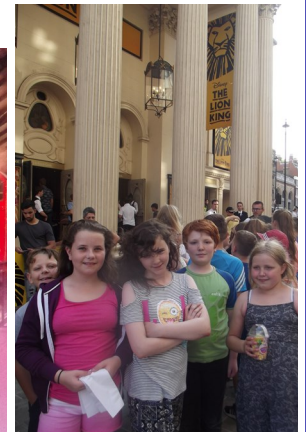
