

## Curriculum Overview for nursery.

### Communication and Language.

- Listening to stories responding to questions and ideas.
- Following instructions to carry out activities.
- Using past, present and future forms of language.
- Listening attentively, including while completing tasks.
- Understanding prepositions such as in, on and under.
- Responding to and asking questions during conversations

### Personal, Social and Emotional development.

- Building confidence to choose activities and discuss ideas.
- Building relationships with adults and other children.
- Playing collaboratively and taking turns.
- Working together to follow the rules and routines in the setting.

### Physical Development

- Developing control and coordination of movement
- Handling equipment and tools, including for writing
- Learning about healthy diet and exercise
- Managing their own hygiene and personal needs

### Literacy.

- Enjoy listening to and joining in with familiar stories and rhymes.
- Join in with key events and repeated refrains from stories.
- Choose and read books for pleasure.
- Write for a variety of purposes around the setting, explaining what these mean to others.

### Mathematics.

- Count reliably with numbers up to 10 then 20.
- Use number names and language spontaneously in their play.
- Start to match number and quantity recognising that it tells us how many in a set.
- Show an awareness of shape and space in their play,
- Start to use positional language.

### Understanding of the world.

- Talk about events in their own lives and their families.
- Talk about the world around them noticing similarities and differences in the environment.
- Recognise and use technology both at home and in school.

### Expressive Arts and Design.

- Learn new songs and dances.
- Take part in role play activities linked to their own experiences.
- Create pictures, models and collages using a range of different media and materials.
