Subject and Content	Ways you can help your child
<p>English: Week 2-3 - We will be writing labels and descriptions of our own superheroes Week 4 - Superhero Riddles Week 5 - Superhero Poetry Week 6 - Instructions Week 7 - descriptive writing linked to Autumn</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read stories with and to your child and talk about the characters, events and where the story takes place. • Make up stories together (no need to write these) using ideas from stories you have shared together. • Make something together and write your own set of instructions
<p>Maths: We will be focusing on the following objectives.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Count, read and write numbers to 100 • Find 1 more or less than a given number • Use language related to length and height • Know and order the days of the week • Number bonds to 10 	<p>Make maths fun, playing board games together as a family is a great way to practise counting. <p>Sculpture Week: In Year 1 the last week of half term is Sculpture week. Children will be looking at the work of famous artists and creating their own sculpture depicting their superhero in a pose of their choice.</p>	<p>Topic: Our main topic for this half term is Superheroes and links well with our work in English. Children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Investigate their 5 senses - Use science skills to investigate different materials <p>We will also have a mini topic looking at the season of Autumn and will complete work in English linked to this.</p>
<p>R.E Children will be introduced to the Christian Bible to help them understand why it is special to Christians and how they treat it with respect.</p>	<p>P.E. We will be playing team games that focus on throwing and defensive skills.</p>
